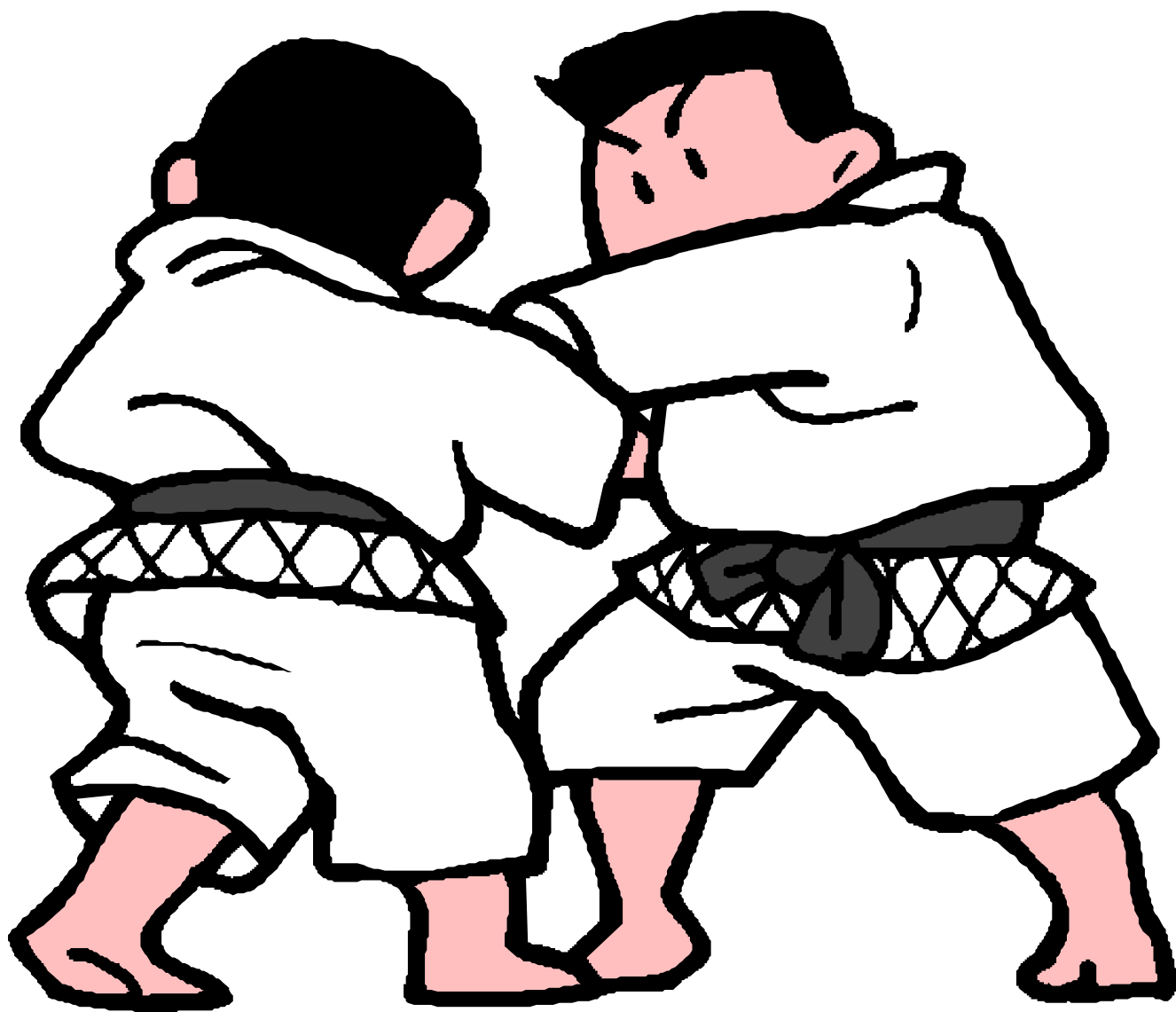

### **Cornishmen v Japanese**

**Test of wrestling styles at Plymouth**

**Yukio Tani the famous Japanese jujitsu wrestler, who had challenged all comers to a trial of skill had exciting encounters with Cornish champions at the Palace Theatre, Plymouth on Monday night. Acceptors of the challenge were the well known Cornish wrestlers George Bazeley of St. Dennis and Fred Richards Old Pound the ex heavy weight champion of England, who won the shield given for the most points in the county of Cornwall competitions last year. The men were brought to Plymouth by Mr. .Tickell hon secretary of the Cornwall wrestling association,, and appeared giants in strength and youth compared to the Jap, who is 58 years of age and only weighs 10 st. Richards a fine specimen of manhood weighs something like 12st 10lb and Bazeley about 12st.**

**The palace audience was on tip toe of expectation when the men were announced. The men wrestled in jackets and Bazeley who was first to try conclusions with Yukio**

**Tani was offered £1 for every minute he stayed over 10 minutes. Both could use the knowledge of Ju –Jitsu and the defeated man would signal his own defeat.**

**At the signal to commence hostilities the pair were quickly locked, and Bazeley soon had his man on the mat, he tried the arm and leg holds but Tani was elusive, and rolled getting Bazeley under. The Japanese wrestler was unable to hold the Cornishman, who again threw Tani and kneeling over him, got him by the neck trying to pin him down both shoulders and one hip, which is the Cornish method of defeating a man. He was unable to hold Tani who wriggled away and quick as lightning slung his leg over the Cornishman's neck securing what is known as a neck hold which is closely akin to a strangle hold.**

**Bazeley could not free himself and the jap thus won after 7 minutes 54 seconds. Some of the audience could not understand and protested, but it was quite fair and Bazeley has offered to meet Tani again with the neck hold barred, a challenge that is accepted.**

**At the second house Richards threw the Japanese champion and held him for 11 ¾ minutes.**

### ***Good performance by Gregory***

**Francis Gregory St ,Wenn the 15 year old youth , who won the “Western Morning News” bantam championship belt in the wrestling competitions in Cornwall, tried conclusions with the Japanese Ju- Jitsu wrestler Yukio Tani, at the palace theatre Plymouth on Tuesday night, and made a very creditable stand for 7 minutes 5 seconds before he was defeated.**

**The finessing was very interesting and a thrill was raised when the Cornish boy threw Tani and tried to pin his shoulders down Cornish style. The Jap squirmed and wriggled and at length planted both feet on Gregory's breast and threw him over his head. The pair were at grips again quickly and Gregory was again on top but the Jap rolled from under and threw his leg over Gregory's neck, and won with an arm and neck hold his knowledge of Ju – Juitsu prevailing.**

**The victor complimented Gregory on his fine performance, and Appolo the well known athlete announced that they were looking for a promising wrestler in England, and hoped to find one in the West of England. The lad Gregory was just the type of man they wanted and he was glad to know that he had entered on a sporting career by winning a valuable belt given by one of the great newspapers. He also mentioned that this Thursday the Cornish champions Bazeley and Richards would again pit their strength against Tani, then the strangle hold would be barred.**
