WHAT IS JUDO?

Judo is a Japanese form of one-to-one wrestling. It originated from the lethal Japanese form of Jujitsu that was practised for centuries in Japan as a self-defence and unarmed combat. The word Judo translates as the gentle or supple way.

GRADES:

The British Judo Council uses the following system of denoting grade. Primary: (5 to 9 year olds)

Wear white belts, with one two or three tabs of red, yellow, orange, green, blue, or brown depending on their proficiency.

Junior: (10 to 15 year olds)

Wear white belts with one, two or three yellow tabs, progressing to yellow belt, then one, two or three orange tabs, orange belt with up to three green tabs, green belt with up to three blue tabs, remaining with a green belt progressing through first three blue tabs, then three brown tabs and finally three black tabs.

Seniors: (16+ years)

6th Kyu White belt

5th Kyu Yellow belt

4th Kyu Orange belt

3rd Kyu Green belt

2nd Kyu Blue belt

1st Kyu Brown belt

1st-5 Dan Black belt

6th-8th Dan Red & White belt

9th-11th Dan Red belt

12th Dan White belt

Note: 10th Dan is the highest grade bestowed by the Kodokan in Japan.
